Helpful Tips

Although some opportunities are different than others, the one common thread for all of them is your **PERSONAL STATEMENT and**

RESUME/CV. The Scholarships and Fellowships Office can help you develop both of these documents. All opportunities are within your reach, and your personal statement and resume/cv are essential components. Being intentional about your experiences at Lafayette is a great way to build a strong personal statement and resume.

- Keep informal records of what you do and what you are involved in. Examples include papers you have written, class research/projects, clubs, organizations, and other activities such as tutoring peers. This helps with securing letters of recommendation and gives a sense of what is important to you.
- Visit the Scholarships & Fellowships Office.
- Visit your Career Services Gateway Counselor.
- Build relationships with your Professors
