The Scholarship offers:

- Fully funded master's or professional degree, including tuition and fees
- A living stipend of \$2,000 Canadian Dollars per month during academic terms
- A one-time relocation grant for moving to Montréal
- Students not pursuing academic term study during the summer may apply for up to \$5,000 to pursue meaningful summer experiences

- You will develop your LEADERSHIP Skills, exploring different approaches to leadership during bi-weekly seminars
- Establish meaningful connections with mentors and advisors
- Learn from and collaborate with peers with a variety of lived experiences and academic paths
